**Friday, April 11: St. Marks Lighthouse Paved Trail Bike Ride**. 34 mile ride begins at St. Marks Trail, Wakulla Station (where restrooms and water are available). Ride description: Ride paved trail 4 miles. At Hwy 98, turn left and ride 3 miles on paved trail. At Lighthouse Road, turn right and follow road 10 miles through refuge. You will need \$2 or a national park pass to enter park. There are bathrooms at the Visitor's Center and at the lighthouse.

**Saturday, April 12: Marshes Sands Paved Trail Bike Ride**. 66 mile ride begins at St. Marks Trail, Wakulla Station.

Ride description: Ride paved trail 4 miles. At Hwy 98, turn right and follow 24.5 miles, connecting to Ochlockonee Bay Trail to Marshes Sands Beach. There are bathrooms at Marshes Sands Beach, but no water. There is a convenience store at the intersection of the Ochlockonee and Coastal Trails.
